|| Group Discussion Guide | Acts 7:20-34 STEPHEN'S SPEECH, PART 3: MOSES



The first two figures that Stephen has covered had Gentile connections— Abraham was called out from Mesopotamia (7: 2-4), and Joseph became a ruler over Egypt (7: 10). Does Moses have a similar Gentile connection?



How might Stephen's speech be a foreshadowing of the transition toward the Gentile mission?



The Israelites Moses sought to defend reject him (v. 27). What does this indicate about the kind of respect Moses had from Israel?



While the council has accused Stephen of blaspheming Moses, Stephen is turning the tables on them. How does his speech reveal how they have rejected (and continue to reject) Moses?



What does God emphasize about himself in his encounter with Moses (v. 30-34)?



God reveals himself to his people—what does this mean for believers today? How does God reveal himself and how are we to respond?



What role does God intend Moses to play in his plan for Israel's deliverance?



Are there any similarities between the mission God gives Moses and the Great Commission of the New Testament church?
