THE ETHIOPIAN EUNUCH: TRUE CONVERSION

- What are the indications from this passage that the Holy Spirit is at work in arranging this "divine appointment"?
- What are the indications that the Ethiopian eunuch experiences true conversion, as opposed to the false conversion of Simon the magician?
- The Ethiopian eunuch had come to Jerusalem and was returning to Ethiopia. How might this passage give us a vision not only for "going to the nations" but being prepared for the "coming of the nations"?
