What is the mission of the local church? How does the Great Commission (Matt. 28:18-20) influence your understanding? Why is such a mission non-negotiable?



What is the difference between mission and missions? Why must the former always precede the latter?



What does it look like for a church to prioritize the Great Commission church? How does the pastor's role to "equip the saints for the work of ministry" (Eph. 4:12) influence your answer?



What are some of the consequences for setting forth a mission of the church not grounded in the Great Commission?



Jesus did not call us to plant churches. Why then is multiplication the vision of the church? (Consider the multitude in Revelation 5 and 7) What is the connection between making disciples and multiplying the church?



Why is the task of church planting the primary symptom (not the source) of effective disciple making? Why is church planting necessary for accomplishing the Great Commission? (Acts 14:19-28)



How can the individual church member contribute to the formation of a missional church culture?



How can a church's leadership structure support its missional strategy? (Titus 1:5) Consider how formalized pipelines and pathways foster a ministry of raising up and sending out leaders.
